A - Algorithm	Like a recipe, it's a list of steps to solve problems or get things done.
B - Bot	A robot helper on the computer that does tasks automatically.
C - Chatbot	A computer buddy you can talk to, like a friendly robot that chats.
D - Data	Bits of information that help computers learn and make decisions.
E - Encryption	A secret code that keeps your data safe.
F - Facial Recognition	A computer that can recognize faces, like magic glasses.
G - Generator	A computer tool that can make cool stuff, like pictures or stories.
H - Hardware	The parts of a computer you can touch, like the keyboard or mouse.
I - Interface	The way you talk or work with a computer, like clicking buttons or typing.
